

# FACT:

# 75% of all water heaters fail before they are 12 years old.

### WHAT TO LOOK FOR:

WATER THAT IS NOT HOT ENOUGH can point towards internal component failure, and it may be time for replacement.

CORRODED CONNECTIONS on the appliance are caused by the reaction of different metal types and may indicate that the protective measures in place are no longer functioning.

NOISES coming from a water heater, such as banging or popping, can be indications that the appliance has an excess amount of sediment in the bottom of the tank. This buildup can cause your appliance to work harder and can lead to premature failure.

# FACT:

# Burst water lines can cause \$6,000\* of damage per incident.

### WHAT TO LOOK FOR:

**PITTING CORROSION** is a sign that a metal supply line has been weakened. Replace any metal lines with rust to avoid leaks.

CALCIFICATIONIS a white crust of mineral deposits left behind when moisture escapes from a loose plumbing connection. Check with a plumber to see if there are any connections that need to be tight ened or replaced.

TOOL MARKS ON PLASTIC CONNECTORS can indicate overtightening and could lead to failure from the plastic cracking. These connections are only intended to be tightened by hand.

### WHAT TO LOOK FOR:

SINGLE STRAND ALUMINUM WIRING makes your home 55x more likely to reach fire hazard conditions than homes wired with copper.\*

**DOUBLE TAPPED WIRING** in the electrical panel can create loose connections damaging your electrical wiring and can potentially cause a fire hazard.

**OBSOLETE ELECTRICAL PANELS** are known to have problems and can be a fire hazard.















